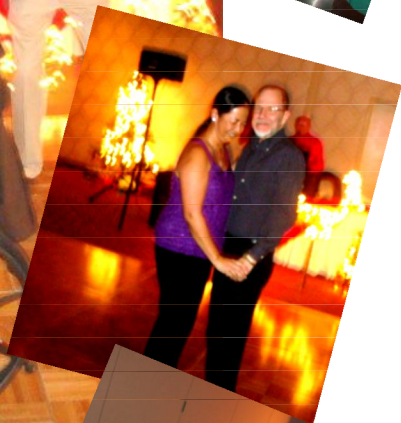
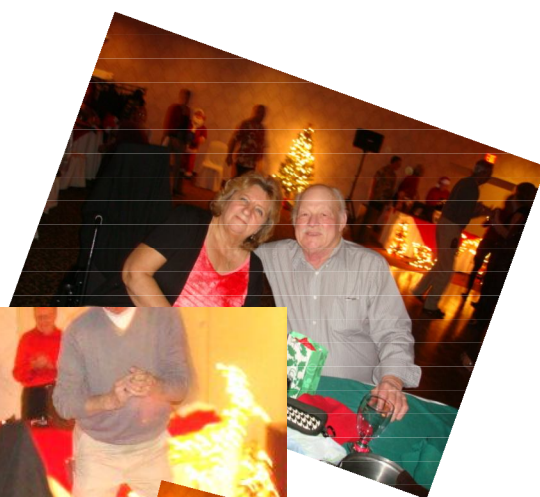
Dec. 12th was a night of great music, great food, and great friends.

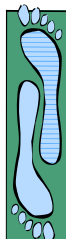

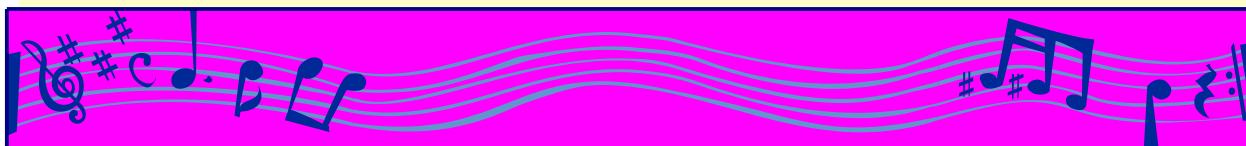
