

Jewel won the hula hoop contest. The last 3 standing were Jewell, Donna, and me. I lost count after 100 turns and knew I would not win.





HE HAS PLAYED BEACH AND SHAG MUSIC IN CLUBS AND DANCE EVENTS IN NEW YORK, MARYLAND, OHIO, PENNSYLVANIA, MISSOURI, ILLINOIS, VIRGINIA, WEST VIRGINIA, NORTH AND SOUTH CAROLINA, TENNESSEE, GEORGIA, AND FLORIDA.

BUTCH WAS INDUCTED INTO THE BEACH MUSIC DJ HALL OF FAME IN 1991.

HE WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN THE INCEPTION AND FORMATION OF THE ASSOCIATION OF BEACH & SHAG CLUBS DJ'S. BUTCH WON THE 1997 SHELL AWARD FOR FAVORITE DEE JAY. IN 2005, HE WON THE LITTLE TOMMY HAMRICK AWARD FOR HIS DEDICATION TO BEACH AND R & B MUSIC FOR THE PAST 20 YEARS AND WAS ALSO VOTED INTO "THE BOYS IN THE O.D. BAND".

HE HAS PLAYED 100'S OF SPA/CSA SANCTIONED DANCE CONTESTS AND WAS THE DJ FOR THE NATIONAL SHAG DANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS IN 1992, 1993, 2004, 2009, 2010. BUTCH ALSO PLAYED THE USA GRAND NATIONAL DANCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA IN 1995, 1997, 1998, 2000 - 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012.
