Craig Jennings played fantastic beach tunes for us, as was evidenced by the crowded dance floor all evening.



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# It's a Good Day to Play

Wes and I attended the ACSC meeting on February 26 in Columbia, South Carolina. What, you ask, is the ACSC? The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs is an organization consisting of over 100 shag dance clubs who were formed with the intention of promoting and preserving beach music and Carolina shag dancing. The ACSC also assists with the planning and promoting of SOS (Society of Stranders) activities held throughout the year in Myrtle Beach, S.C.

The Battlefield Boogie Club joined the ACSC in 2008. In doing so, the BBC pays dues of \$50 per year, and is obligated to attend four ACSC meetings a year and to take part in the sale of Fun Monday raffle tickets and SOS cards. The ACSC reimburses the BBC \$400 a year to help offset travel and lodging expenses for the Board members who attend the meetings. The meetings help to keep clubs informed about the SOS activities, programs, charities, etc. While at these meetings, member clubs also vote for ACSC/SOS board members.

A few tidbits of information we received:

- \*At the SOS Mid-Winter Classic 1,772 SOS cards were sold \$53,160
- \*ACSC member shag clubs sold 2,470 SOS cards \$135,257 (Our BBC sold 12!)
- \*There is a Company Store, owned and operated by the ACSC in Myrtle Beach, that sells SOS and shag dance related items/memorabilia. Rental of this cute location on Ocean Drive is only \$700 per month!! Check it out while you are there for SOS. And, it's not too late to purchase those SOS cards—they are a good deal!!
- \*A new shag dance/beach music book is due out in 2012. Written by USC professor, Tom Poland, <u>Bury My Heart at Ocean Drive</u>, is about the history of Carolina shag dancing, its music and it's people. Be on the lookout for this!

The ACSC meetings also allow its members to meet many folks who all have one thing in common – the love of shag dancing. The host club, The Columbia Shag Club, formed in 1980, was the first shag club in the ACSC, which was established in 1984. As hosts, The Columbia members offered the finest of South Carolina hospitality. The weekend theme was 'It's A Good Day To Play!!!' and combined the best of beach music, food, drinks, and lots of idea exchanging.

Columbia, the capital city of South Carolina, is home to the University of South Carolina and its beauty was apparent in the spring flowering trees, tulips and daffodils. We were able to spend some time sightseeing and, yes, I did find a quilt shop! Believe it or not, we met someone who had just moved to Columbia just a few weeks ago—from Stafford County!!
