HALLOWEEN PARTY!

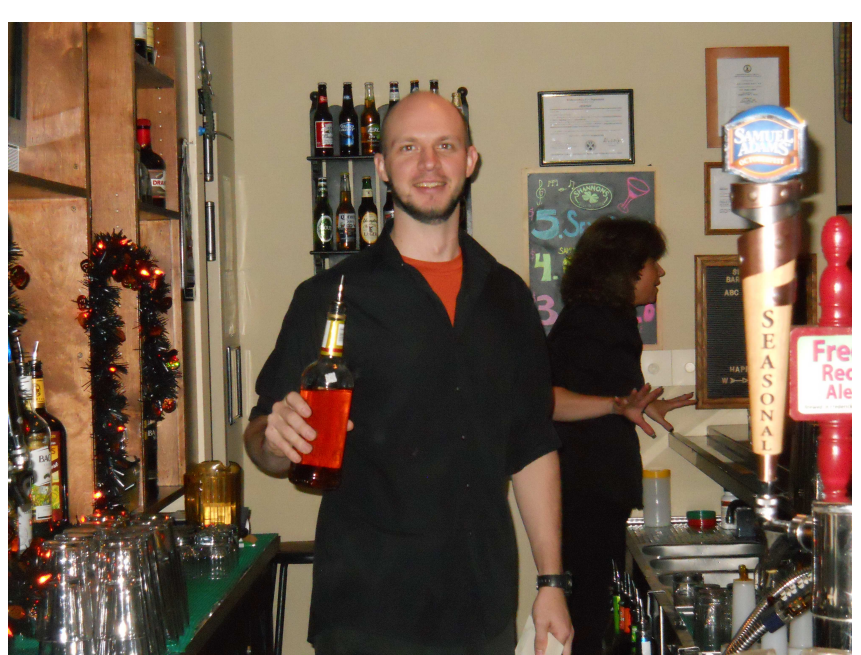


